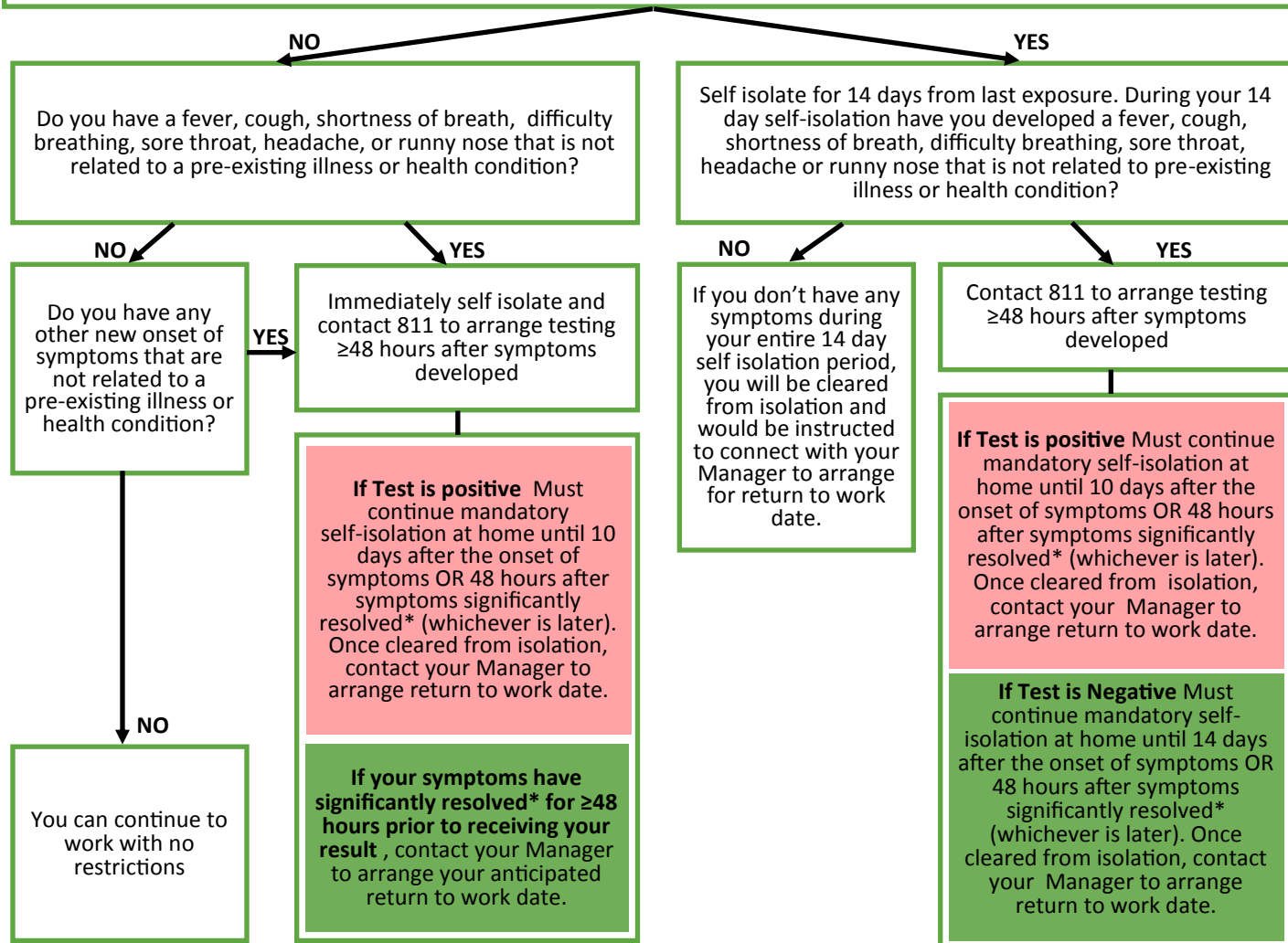




In the past 14 days have you:

- Been named a close contact, by Occupational Health Safety or Population Public Health, to a person who received a laboratory confirmed COVID-19 positive result or
- Have you travelled outside of Canada?



- ***Significantly resolved:**
 - Refers to when symptoms are notably improved.
 - This may require discussion with a care provider.
 - The recovery of COVID-19 varies from person to person. Note—absence of cough is not required for those known to have a chronic or lingering cough, wheezing or shortness of breath.
- If your potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus is related to a workplace exposure then report your work related incident as per your organization's employees workplace procedures.
- A close contact is defined as :
 - ◇ A person who provided direct patient care without consistent and appropriate use of recommended personal protective equipment (PPE); **OR**
 - ◇ A person who has had close prolonged (≥15 minutes) contact within 2 metres with a probable or confirmed COVID -19 case; **OR**
 - ◇ A person who had direct contact with infectious body fluid with a positive COVID-19 case (ex. Coughed or sneezed on) without the use of PPE.
- Testing must occur at least 48 hours after symptom onset, to avoid false negatives. For more information, see: <https://www.saskatchewan.ca/government/health-care-administration-and-provider-resources/treatment-procedures-and-guidelines/>

- If test results are positive, you will be contacted by a Health Care professional to determine appropriate direction.
- If test results are Negative, you will be notified.
- If test results are Negative and symptoms have not resolved after 7 days, contact your Health Care Provider
