Safety for Supervisors Contingency Training



Safety for Supervisors Overview - Required Training

SASWH's Safety for Supervisors course introduces supervisors to key legislated responsibilities for occupational health and safety at the workplace. It provides supervisors with the information they need to create and promote a safe work environment, prevent workplace injuries and illnesses and develop a safety culture in the workplace.

1. Safety For Supervisor online and virtual classroom

***Split Classroom** requires the completion of self-directed online education followed by facilitated virtual classroom training.

- a. Register for a **4 Hour virtual classroom** facilitated session, then complete the online course
- b. **Important:** schedule accordingly so the online is completed as close to the virtual classroom session as possible. In order to be successful in the classroom component, participants must be able to remember and recall the learnings from the online content.
- c. Note: Traditionally a 6 week window is allowed however during this time it is recommended to complete the total content online and virtual classroom within a shorter timeframe.

MATERIALS

- SASWH's Safety for Supervisors workbook will be provided to each participant during the classroom session.
- A copy of, or access to, the following current legislation is required in order for supervisors to complete the online course:
 - *Saskatchewan Employment Act (SEA) Part III - Occupational Health and Safety (proclaimed April 29th, 2014)*
 - *The Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, 1996 (amended 2012, 2014)*
 - *The Occupational Health and Safety (Workplace Hazardous Materials Information Systems) Regulations (effective August 17/16)*

ON GOING SUPPORT

- SASWH is available to guide and support participants during and after the session to clarify application of the learnings to the workplace. Additionally, the expectation is that the healthcare employer provides onsite support to supervisors as they begin to apply their learnings in their day to day work.

All potential participants are to register through their normal training registration process.
