

Sask Central Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) Outreach was at One Arrow First Nation August 17 sharing information about ATV (All-Terrain Vehicle) safety with local youth & families at a safety carnival organized by One Arrow & Saskatoon Tribal Justice, in partnership with SGI.

Watermelon drop demonstrations highlighting the importance of wearing an ATV helmet were a launching point for conversations about four-wheel safety. ABI Outreach also assisted ATV riders in finding their best helmet fit, & in some cases, replacing helmets that were outgrown or expired.

One Arrow First Nation is part of the Saskatoon Tribal Council, and is located just south of Batoche near the South Saskatchewan River.
