

Derek Miller, Acting Vice President, Infrastructure, Information and Support

In December 2021, Derek was named Acting Vice President of Infrastructure, Information and Support (IIS). The IIS portfolio oversees Nutrition and Food Services, Environmental Services, Infrastructure Management, Health Emergency Management, Digital Health, and Privacy and Health Information Management.

Prior to being named Acting VP of IIS, Derek served as the Commander of the Emergency Operations Centre leading the SHA's response to the COVID pandemic.

Derek's permanent role at the SHA is as Executive Director of Infrastructure from February 2018 to December 2021. In this role, his infrastructure related responsibilities include: maintenance, real estate, capital planning/project management, asset management, clinical engineering, health emergency management and security.

Derek joined the SHA from the former Prairie North Health Region where he was VP of Finance and Operations, and also Project Lead for the Saskatchewan Hospital North Battleford – Integrated Corrections Facility Project.

Prior to moving to Saskatchewan, Derek served in the Canadian Forces for 20 years, where his leadership experience ranged from the role of Commanding Officer of a health services centre in Trenton, ON to leading national level procurement projects for the Canadian Forces Health Services Group Headquarters in Ottawa. Derek's educational preparation includes a Master in Business Administration from the University of Manitoba, Bachelor of Arts from the Royal Military College of Canada and Certificate in Health Services Management from Ryerson University. He is a Certified Health Executive with the Canadian College of Health Leaders.
