Dr. David Mulder is a graduate of the University of Saskatchewan and completed his training in General Surgery at the Montreal General Hospital. He followed this with a specialized training in Chest Surgery at the University of Iowa and also has a Master's of Science from McGill University. Dr. David Mulder is a former Surgeon-in-chief of the Montreal General Hospital (MGH), Chairman of the Department of Surgery and Director of the Division of Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery at McGill University. Currently he is the senior staff surgeon at the MUHC Department of Surgery, Division of Thoracic Surgery and current Chief Surgeon of the Montreal Canadiens organization and has been honored by the MUHC community with the naming of the Dr. David S. Mulder Trauma Centre at the Montreal General Hospital. Over the course of his distinguished career, Dr. Mulder has played a prominent role in the development of clinical care, teaching and research at the MUHC and McGill University, as well as the restructuring of trauma care in the province of Quebec. A leader in traumatology and cardio-thoracic surgery, he is one of the reasons the Montreal General Hospital is ranked among the top trauma centres in Quebec.
