North East 5

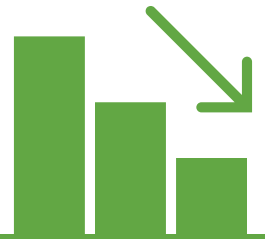
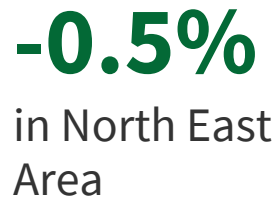
North East 5 encompasses a geographic area stretching from Smeaton in the west to the Manitoba border in the east. Nipawin is the largest community in the Network.
