North East 8

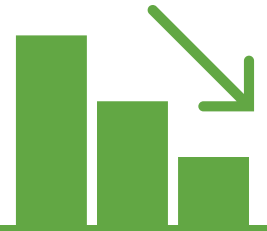
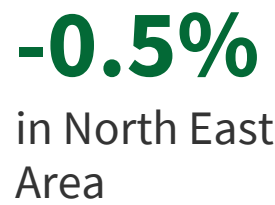
North East 8 encompasses a geographic area stretching from Tisdale in the west, past Hudson Bay, to the Manitoba border in the east. Tisdale is the largest community in the Network.
