South East 1 is a large narrow area stretching north of Humboldt to south of Strasbourg. Humboldt is the largest community in the Network.



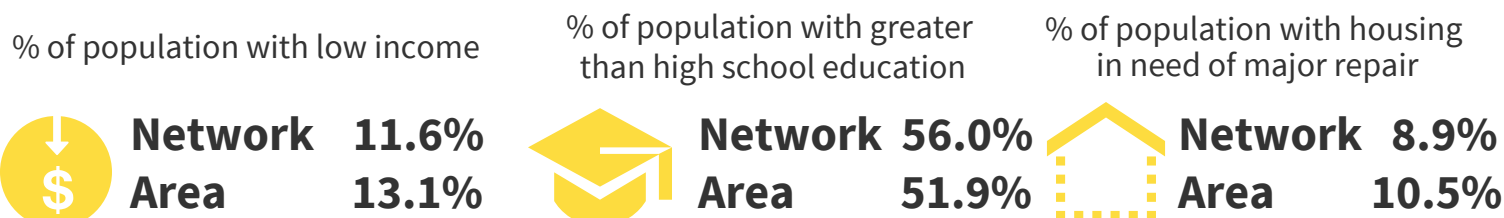

Projected population changes (2018 - 2035)²

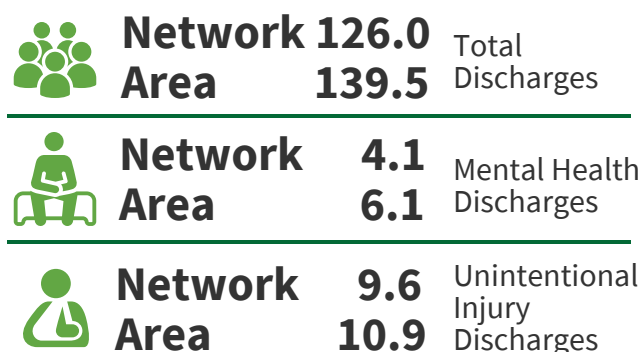


Network 1 has favourable socio-economic indicators.¹

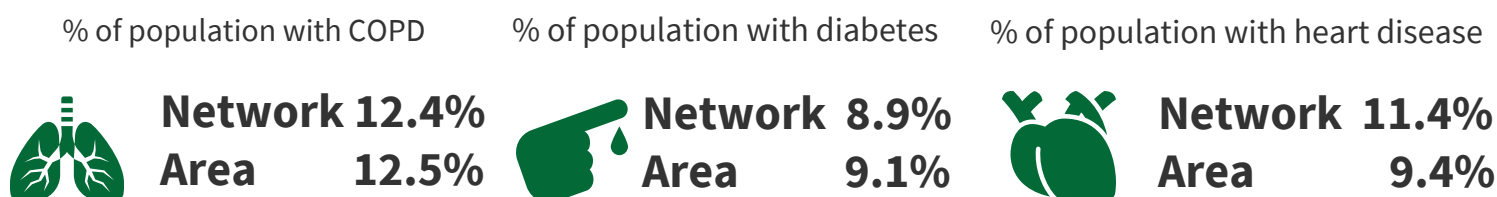


Network 1 has rates **lower than Area averages** on all hospital discharge indicators.³
