South East 7

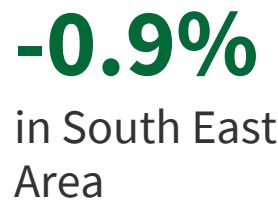
South East 7 is a geographic area straddling the Manitoba border from Rocanville in the north to Redvers in the south. Moosomin is the largest community in the Network.
