The National Day of Reconciliation also known as Orange shirt day was established by grass roots First Nation, Métis and Inuit communities to bring awareness of the inter-generational impacts of residential schools and the importance of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada (TRC).

The story of the orange shirt originates from Phyllis Webstad's story about her residential school lived experience. The orange shirt is a symbol that honours all the children, families who survived or did not make it home from residential schools.
