Saskatoon Festival of Trees: Nov. 25-Dec. 3 Gingerbread Lane

Share your creativity with thousands of people and be part of a great tradition that's a delight to see and smell! Your involvement will help bring the magic of the holiday season to Saskatoon.



How it works:

Note that you're required to provide all materials, tools, lights and batteries. A plywood base will be provided and can be picked up at a designated festival site on **Oct. 4**; alternatively, some will be made available for pick-up at SCH Foundation office once you've registered. You'll also need to transport or deliver your gingerbread display to the Western Development Museum by **Nov. 24**. The gingerbread display then becomes the property of and is sold during the Festival.

All SCH department entries will be displayed in their own special category and will be eligible for the People's Choice award, as voted by Festival of Trees attendees and tabulated by festival staff. But there's more than just bragging rights involved. Saskatoon City Hospital Foundation will present the winning department with a \$5,000 grant towards a suitable request in their area, such as equipment, resource programming, education, or patient comfort items!

The winning department or department representative's display will be the one with the highest number of People's Choice votes. The grant will be paid by the Foundation to the SHA on behalf of the winning staff person or department upon agreement of the use of funds between the winning staff person or department and Saskatoon City Hospital Foundation. This grant is not eligible to be paid to an individual(s).
