### Presenter

**Demetry Assimakopoulos, Sp. Hons. BA, DC**

Dr. Demetry Assimakopoulos graduated from The Canadian Memorial Chiropractic College in 2012. Dr. Demetry previously worked as part of the interdisciplinary team at the University Health Network's (UHN) Rehabilitation Pain Service (RPS). This specialized inter-disciplinary program works to manage very complex chronic pain cases as part of an integrated team, to determine the best possible clinical pathways for individual patients. Dr. Demetry was the first chiropractor to join the UHN RPS Program, and has since started the very first Chiropractic Clinic in the hospital. Furthermore, Dr. Demetry has begun teaching a course to second year Chiropractic Sports Sciences and Clinical Sciences Residency graduate students at CMCC. Each student also takes part in a 2-3 month rotation with Dr. Demetry in his clinical settings.

Dr. Demetry also treats chronic pain patients Pain and Wellness Centre in Maple Ontario. The Pain and Wellness Centre offers Ontario's only government-funded interdisciplinary pain program, which offers a spectrum of treatments for chronic pain, including chiropractic services, physical rehabilitation, naturopathy, healthy eating, lifestyle counseling, psychological counselling, mindfulness and meditation, pharmacological treatment and interventional therapies. Furthermore, Dr. Demetry teaches continuing education courses on the topic of chronic pain throughout Canada, and is a frequent contributor to RRS Education.

The future of our profession lies in working collaboratively with other healthcare providers in interdisciplinary settings. This lecture will examine the factors that can ensure success in these integrated and collaborative settings, from the standpoint of a chiropractor with a decade of experience in interdisciplinary chronic pain management.
