Dr. Emary will speak about his exciting research projects, including work with the Langs Community Health Centre (mixed methods related to prescription opioids) and a major new pilot cluster randomized controlled trial (RCT) focused on chiropractic care and opioid use among adults with chronic non-cancer spinal pain.
