## About Us:

The Family Treatment Centre is a six week inpatient addictions program for female caregivers and their children. Our program is trauma informed and is designed to anchor the family to a healthier way of life through healing and empowerment. FTC is for women who are motivated to stop the cycle of substance misuse in their family.

The goal for treatment is to support clients while they learn the skills and gather the information they need to successfully manage their addiction so that it does not have a negative impact on their lives and the lives of their children.



Our case management approach covers the holistic teaching of 4 key elements of recovery which includes the spiritual, emotional, mental and physical health of our caregivers and their children.

## What to Expect:

Our daily schedule consists of both individual and family programming on Monday-Friday from 9:00-4:45 & Tuesday-Thursday from 6:00-8:00.

On weekends, families enjoy daily leave passes to shop for essentials or visit loved ones. They can also remain in the centre to enjoy quality family time.

24hour staffing is available to support our caregivers with parenting routines and possible challenges.

At FTC Caregivers and children have specialized living quarters which allows families to live together as a single family unit.

## Safe Community:

At FTC our goal is to maintain a safe and secure environment for our families who are healing. We ask that everyone is treated with respect.

We are a Saskatchewan Health Authority facility therefore, we ensure a confidential environment. We also ensure the secure collection and storage of all personal health information.

## Programming Fundamentals:

Family Treatment Centre is proud to offer programming developed by Dr. Stephanie Covington as the foundation of our teachings. Dr. Covington is a pioneer in the fields of addiction, trauma, and recovery. She has developed innovative, gender-responsive, and trauma-informed material.
