Over 20 grade 10 students from Beatty's & Okemasis Cree Nation and One Arrow First Nation High Schools engaged in hands-on health career exploration at a recent Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) event held on May 14, 2025, at the Wakaw Primary Health and Collaborative Emergency Centre. Students had the opportunity to engage in 16 different live demonstrations and conversations with health-care professionals. Through these experiences, students gained valuable insights into over 20 career opportunities throughout the SHA. Many careers were highlighted such as lab and medical imaging, family medicine, mental health and addictions, nursing, EMS, chronic disease management, food and nutrition services, population and public health, administration/scheduling, and therapies.
