

Child Health Clinics (January 1 – March 31, 2026)

First Immunizations are due at 2 months of age.

Please book your appointment as soon as possible by contacting your local Public Health Office.

Public Health Nurses provide **free** routine immunizations funded by the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health.

A parent or legal guardian must be present to provide informed consent for immunization.

Standard appointment:

- For families who do not have a routine family physician.
- Routine immunization.
- Support for parents in promoting healthy childhood growth & development and answer questions.
- Offered at booked appointments only

Immunization Express appointment (20 minutes):

- For infants and children 6 years and younger seen regularly by a family physician.
- All age-appropriate vaccines are provided. Height, weight and screenings are not repeated.

Call 6 weeks in advance to book your appointment. If you are unable to attend, please let us know as soon as possible.

***Arrive 10 minutes early for your appointment to fill out forms. Allow 30 minutes for your child's first appointment.**
