- Currently 16 years of age or older
- Currently pursuing High School diploma
- Interested in pursuing a Health Care career upon graduation

HOW MUCH WILL YOU EARN?

You will earn an hourly wage of \$23.17 (step 1)

INCENTIVES:

Following graduation, if pursuing health related education, you could be eligible for bursaries based on hours worked:

Up to 112 = \$500

Between 113 and 300 = \$1000
