Launched on October 16, 2023, the Advance Care Planning Program (ACPP) is a provincial initiative providing support and services for health care professionals and the public surrounding advance care planning (ACP).

We are a team of Health Educators, a Medical Director, and a Program Director dedicated to supporting health care professionals in delivering care that aligns with patients' wishes and applicable legislation, while empowering the public to express their health care preferences.

Services Provided

We provide education, consultation, and guidance to health care professionals on advance care planning, health care directives, substitute decision-makers, SMOST, and the use of clinical tools and forms.

We provide education and information to the public on the importance of advance care planning, engaging in ACP conversations, and documenting their health care preferences. We also offer a mail-out service for the Yellow Sleeve Program.

We develop helpful resources for staff and the public, which are available on our program website.
